



2012-2013 Scholarship Application

Students must complete and submit this application to be considered for the scholarships awarded by the Spartanburg Community College Scholarship Committee. This application must be completed with the most up-to-date information available. If financial need is an award requirement, your 2012-2013 financial aid file must be completed by the deadline date of July 2, 2012. After reviewing applications, a specific scholarship committee may require additional information to be submitted before a winner is selected. If needed, you will be notified by mail.

Steps to Apply:

1. Apply for and be admitted to Spartanburg Community College which includes submitting your final, official high school transcript to the SCC admissions center.
2. Complete a *2012-2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid* at www.fafsa.gov. (Results take 2-4 weeks. SCC's Title IV School Code is 003994.)
3. If you are a transfer student, attach a transcript from each college or university attended.
4. Complete the attached application and submit it to the financial aid office. All items must be completed in ink or typewritten. Place an "NA" in each item that does not apply to you.
5. Have at least two letters of recommendation sent to the financial aid office. These letters of recommendation should come from current or former educators who can comment on your academic activities.
6. Submit an essay, 500 words or less, which discusses your program of study, employment opportunities associated with this program of study and your life goals.
Please note: If you are a single parent of a child under the age of ten, also include details in your essay about how your child will be cared for during completion of your program of study and the benefits that completing your education will have on you and your child.

Spartanburg Community College Scholarships

The following scholarships may be awarded for the 2012-2013 academic year and have a July 2, 2012 application deadline. To be considered for any of these scholarships, please complete the attached application and submit the required letters of recommendation and essay (see Steps to Apply).

Arts & Sciences Division

The Debra Ann Kay Memorial Scholarship-Returning, full-time in AA or AS with a minimum 3.25 GPA.

The Richard & Shirley Gage Brazilian Friendship Scholarship-Full-time in a horticulture program with a minimum 2.0 GPA.

The Piedmont Interstate Fair Horticultural Scholarship-Full-time in the associate degree in horticulture program with a minimum 2.75 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement and student must be a resident of Cherokee, Laurens, Spartanburg or Union County in S.C. or of Polk or Rutherford County in N.C.

Spartanburg Lions Club Scholarship for the Blind-Full-time student in the Cooperative Program of the Deaf and the Blind enrolled in AA or AS with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The Jimmy Painter Horticulture Scholarship-Full-time in the associate degree in horticulture program and a resident of any county in S.C. other than Spartanburg or Cherokee or a resident of any State other than S.C.

Business and Computer Technologies Division

Extended Stay Hotels Scholarship-First-time freshman with a minimum 3.0 high school GPA enrolled in at least six credit hours in a business or computer technology program. Financial need is an award requirement. Recipient must maintain 3.0 GPA.

The Boyce Hensley Achievement Award-Enrolled in computer technology program.

The Shirley M. Tillotson Memorial Scholarship-Full-time in an administrative office technology program with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

The John B. White Scholarship-Full-time in a Business Technology Division program with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Financial need will be the primary consideration.

The James C. Wood Scholarship-Returning, full-time in a Business Technology Division program with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

Health & Human Services Division

The Spartanburg County Medical Society Health Careers Scholarship-Full-time in an associate degree or diploma program in the Health and Human Services Division. Does not apply to general technology-advanced childcare management or expanded duty dental assisting. Financial need is an award requirement and must be a Spartanburg County resident.

The Joe R. & Joella F. Utey Surgical Technology Scholarship-Full-time in surgical technology with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The Joe. R. & Joella F. Utey Radiologic Technology Scholarship-Full-time in radiologic technology with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The J.M. Smith Scholarship-At least six credit hours in pharmacy technician program with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

The Watts Dental Scholarship-Returning, non-traditional student in expanded duty dental assisting with a minimum 2.5 GPA and is a single parent of a minor child. Financial need is an award requirement.

The Dr. Julian and Elizabeth Williams Nursing Scholarship-Returning, full-time, non-traditional student in the associate degree in nursing program with a minimum 2.5 GPA and is a single parent of a minor child. Financial need is an award requirement.

Industrial and Engineering Technologies Division

The Vic Bailey Ford Asset Scholarship-Full-time in automotive technology Ford Asset with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

The Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning Technology Scholarship-Full-time in an HVAC program with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The Wil Myers Memorial Scholarship-Engineering Technology Division program with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement and must be a Spartanburg County resident.

Additional Scholarships

The Foster and Ruth Chapman Single Parent Achievement Award-Full-time in a technology program, will take at least 75% of the required courses at SCC and is a single parent of a child under the age of 10. Must have high school diploma or GED.

The Chris Duerksen Memorial Scholarship-At least six credit hours of remedial "transitional" courses. Financial need is an award requirement.

The John C. Johnson Memorial Scholarship-Full-time in an associate degree program with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The Eleanor J. and James P. Ledbetter, Jr. Memorial Scholarship-Full-time with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The John A. Squires Memorial Alumni Scholarship-Full-time with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

The Charles R. Sanders Scholarship-Full-time with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

The Benjamin D. Snoddy Scholarship-At least six credit hours with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

The Bruce Harris Memorial Scholarship-At least six credit hours with a minimum 3.0 GPA.

The Leroy Sellars Memorial Scholarship-Full-time with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Financial need is an award requirement.

Spartanburg County Foundation Scholarship-Graduate of a Spartanburg County High School. Financial need is an award requirement.

Water Environment Association of SC (WEASC) Scholarship-At least six credit hours enrolled in associate degree in one of the following programs; pre-engineering, horticulture, radiation protection, electronics engineering, engineering, mechatronics, automated manufacturing, industrial electricity, or industrial electronics with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Must be a South Carolina resident.
