Established in June 2006 and strategically located near the I-85 corridor in Upstate South Carolina, the **Center for Business & Entrepreneurial Development** is on the Tyger River Campus of Spartanburg Community College on Highway 290 in Duncan, South Carolina.

This 363,000 square foot multi-use facility located just 15 minutes from Spartanburg and less than 30 minutes from Greenville, is an invaluable tool for qualifying individuals and businesses to start up a new venture, jump start an expansion or relocation, beta test a new product line or train new or existing employees on new products or processes. The versatility of the facility's design and usage makes it the ideal location for the start up of a light manufacturing company, the expansion of a quality service provider, the relocation of a logistics firm or the employment and training of a firm's workforce.

In exchange for services provided through limited-time agreements, clients of the Center agree to locate their permanent facility in Spartanburg County. The resulting benefits include an increase in jobs, revenues and product and process innovation for Spartanburg County, the Upstate region and the state of South Carolina.

**Services: Soft Landings** assists established foreign or domestic companies start new operations in the U.S. and locate in Spartanburg County. The program provides coordinated contacts for services like cultural assistance, language translation services, entry assistance, immigration and visa assistance, government regulations, accounting, financial, legal, housing assistance, utilities and many other services. In addition, the program is designed to provide information and coordinated resources for companies to include training seminars, technical support, global trade information, market research, referrals, community relations and networking.
