

SC Workforce & Industrial Needs Scholarship

The SC Workforce & Industrial Needs Scholarship (SCWINS) is a statewide technical college scholarship program designed to address workforce shortages in South Carolina. The scholarship supplements the Lottery Tuition Assistance Program to help cover any tuition and mandatory fees left after applying all other scholarships and grants.

Students are eligible for a SC Workforce & Industrial Needs Scholarship (SCWINS) award, if they are receiving a Lottery Tuition Assistance scholarship (LTA) for the current academic year and meet one of the following criteria:

- Majoring in a critical work force area as defined by the State Board of Technical and Comprehensive Education (see Appendix A for a list of eligible SCC majors), or
- Meets the USDA income eligibility guidelines for free and reduced-priced meals (see Appendix B for the USDA income eligibility guidelines), or
- Receives Free and Reduced Priced Meals (dual enrollment students only).

Students must also meet these additional eligibility criteria

- No defaulted federal student loans or grant overpayments
- Be a resident of South Carolina
- Not receiving Veteran Chapter 31 or 33 benefits
- Not received a certificate, diploma, or associate degree within past 5 years
- Has a GPA of 2.00 or higher, if 24 credit hours or more
- Must meet all requirements for the Lottery Tuition Assistance Program.

A student must be pursuing a certificate, diploma or degree from one of the 16 technical colleges within South Carolina Technical College System. A Student can receive the SCWINS for only one certificate, diploma or degree unless the additional certificate, diploma or degree constitutes progression in the same field of study.

All eligible students must enroll in at least six (6) credit hours in order to be eligible for a SCWINS funds disbursement. The student cannot be enrolled only in remedial course work. At least one class must be a non-remedial course.

Students who are in a critical workforce major are eligible for an annual \$300 book allotment.

The student must have at least \$1 in LTA funds disburse in order to have any SCWINS funds disburse. If no LTA funds disburse, the student is not eligible for any SCWINS funds to disburse including any of the book allotment. Changes in a student's financial aid package can affect both LTA and SCWINS eligibility. Should tuition and mandatory fees be covered by other forms of aid therefore causing LTA not to disburse, the student will lose eligibility for their SCWINS disbursement including eligibility for the book allotment.
