

# **Biology Policy for ADN Program**

### TIME-LIMIT:

The time limit (expiration date) for biology (BIO 210, 211, and 225) courses is 5 years.

#### Example:

5 year expiration- Applicant accepted for Fall 2022 (May 2022 applicants), BIO 210 completed Fall 2016 expired; BIO 211 Spring 2017 accepted.

#### **ATTEMPTS:**

The student is allowed only 2 attempts in Biology courses within a 5 year period, with a withdrawal counting as an attempt.

# Example:

Student takes BIO 210 Spring 2018 and withdraws from the course. Summer 2018 they repeat the course earning a D. If the student repeats the course Fall 2018 and is successful, they may continue with the remaining biology courses. On the selective ranking sheet, the student would earn 0 points for BIO 210. The student would not be eligible to earn points for the course on the selective ranking sheet until Summer/Fall 2023.

## **COURSE COMPLETION:**

BIO 210, BIO 211, and BIO 225 must be completed by the time the student enters the program.

\*\*Students applying for Spring (January) admission may apply to the program, but all courses must be completed in the preceding Fall semester. Courses in progress will not be awarded points.

## BIO 215 & BIO 216:

If both BIO 215 and BIO 216 are successfully completed, with a "C" or better, they will substitute for BIO 210 and BIO 211. However, if a student has only completed BIO 215, it will NOT substitute for BIO 210.
