### Testing Integrity

The purpose of testing is to demonstrate the outcomes of skills and knowledge. An essential value in testing is presenting one's own work and properly acknowledging that of others. Any violation of this principle constitutes testing dishonesty and is liable to result in the invalidation of scores.

Forms of academic dishonesty include:

- Plagiarism – submitting all or part of another's work as one's own in an examination, computer program, or written work.
- Cheating – using or trying to use unauthorized materials on an examination, such as unauthorized texts or notes or improperly obtaining or trying to obtain copies of an examination or answers to an examination.
- Facilitating Testing Dishonesty – helping another commit an act of testing dishonesty, such as substitution for an examination or completing work for someone else.
- Fabrication – altering or transmitting, without authorization, testing information, or records.

I understand that the following are acts of testing dishonesty:

- Sharing information about this test with another candidate who has not taken it.
  - Accepting information about this test from another candidate who has already taken it.
