

INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE  
Spartanburg County Employee Health Clinic

Spartanburg Community College intends to sole source the procurement of a contract to Spartanburg County Employee Health Clinic for providing health services at no cost to all SCC Employees, including part-time, temporary employees, and adjunct instructors who do not qualify for health insurance otherwise. There are no other health service options available that provide this type of all-inclusive service to individuals who are not covered by insurance.

The Spartanburg County Employee Health Clinic is, and has been, a well-established resource providing its full and part-time employees with first point of contact health services since 2009. The clinic's close proximity to both SCC Central and Downtown campuses is also a primary consideration for convenience and accessibility.

The County of Spartanburg contracts the services of Spartanburg Regional Health System to staff the clinic and provide certain lab and other related services at either no or low cost to the employee. The County facility has negotiated their costs for operating the facility directly with SHRS and does not process their services through the state's health insurance plan thereby offsetting and reducing the outlay of self-funded employer health benefit costs to health care providers through the insurance plan.
