We are adding the following Section:

III. SCOPE OF WORK/SPECIFICATIONS

TIME FOR COMPLETION

The project, including all incidentals and associated work (stripping and signage, cleanup, demobilization, etc) shall be completed to the satisfaction of the College within 45 days from a Notice to Proceed to be issued by the SCC after a 10 day protest period. The unit prices and associated base bid amount should reflect the 45 day base schedule for completion.

The Bidding Schedule contains an alternate bid item for added costs associated with an expedited schedule in order to complete the work no later than May 15th, 2016 so as to be complete prior to a planned special event requiring the use of the parking lot. If this option is selected by Spartanburg Community College there will be no allowance or accommodations made for any delays and the project must be completed by May 15th. The offeror (contractor) must include any and all anticipated costs associated with this expedited schedule such that any delays due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances can be overcome by whatever means necessary in order to complete the work by May 15th.

On Pages 10 and 11

We are deleting the strike through items and adding the highlighted areas:

MILL AND RESURFACE ASPHALT PARKING LOT

Description of Project:

Resurfacing and pavement repairs of an existing parking lot and drives consisting of approximately ~~42,000~~ **46,000** square feet.

Scope of work:

Mill and remove 2 inches of asphalt and resurface with 2 inch hot mix asphalt surface an existing parking lot and associated drives and entrances along with all related incidental work, pavement markings and signage. In addition, perform **stone base repair**, crack sealing, ~~full depth patching, isolation stripping~~, and sealcoating as required or directed. All material, equipment and labor to perform the work generally described herein.

Work Included:

- a. The milling to a depth of 2-inches of existing asphalt surfaces over the areas indicated; including hauling and proper disposal or recycle of milled material to include any and all associated costs and/or fees.
- b. **Reshaping, grading, and compaction as necessary to restore the existing base to suitable conditions for the installation of hot mix asphalt surface. Excavation and removal of unsuitable base materials is not included. Any unsuitable materials encountered should be brought to the attention of the College as soon as they are encountered.** ~~Excavation of areas requiring full depth patching, including hauling and disposal of waste excavated materials regardless of type and any associated disposal fees.~~
- c. Installation of 2-inches of new hot mix asphalt surface course, associated binders/tack, all necessary labor, equipment, hauling, and materials.
- d. Installation of hot applied thermoplastic crack seal materials as directed, including all necessary crack preparation.
- e. Installation of pavement markings including standard parking spaces, handicap accessible spaces, and driveway/roadway centerlines and arrows.
- f. Installation of new MUTCD/ADA compliant signage for handicap parking and stopping locations.
- g. Protection of adjacent areas and landscape.

On Page 12

We are adding the following Sections:

Signage

- 1 Install five (5) handicap accessible parking signs at locations designated by owner, to include one (1) van accessible space. Signage and installation to be MUTCD and ADA compliant.
- 2 Install two (2) MUTCD compliant Stop signs to replace existing stop signs.

Asphalt Emulsion Sealcoat / Coal Tar Sealcoat

- 1 Application of asphalt sealcoat shall be by mechanical means using rubber faced squeegees, brooms, distributor bar/wand in combination. Two (2) coat application.

- a. First coat mechanical squeegee self-propelled recommended/ Wand Allowed
 - b. 2nd coat by spray wand to lock down exposed aggregate and to return the parking lot to a proper aesthetic appearance free of streaks and marks
 - c. The addition of sand shall target 3 lbs-4 lbs per gallon
 - d. Striping for parking and traffic flow should be done only after the sealcoat has dried completely.
 - e. Upon request, contractor may be required to supply Owner with scale tags, for the project containing the following:
 - i. Product name
 - ii. Project name and location
 - iii. Gallons supplied for the project (s)
 - f. Application rates recommended by the Asphalt Sealcoat Manufacturers Association: Rough, aged surface 40 gallons per 1,000 SF
- 2 Asphalt emulsion approved manufacturers or equal. (Approved by SCC).
- a. Neyra Industries, Inc. Paveshield/Tarconite.
 - b. Sealmaster, (PPM) Polymer-Modified Masterseal AE/CT.
 - c. Vance Brothers, Ultraseal/ProtecTar Coal Tar Emulsion.
 - d. Equals must be pre-approved by Spartanburg Community College Facility Manager or his designee.
- 3 Surface to receive sealcoat must be free of all foreign material and dry immediately prior to application of sealer.
- 4 Oil- Grease spots should be treated with one of the following or an approved product prior to the application.
- a. Neyra Oil Seal
 - b. Sealmaster Petro Seal, or equal
- 5 Cleaning by air blowing, vacuum, mechanical sweeper, or techniques approved by SCC.
- 6 Cracks in excess of 1/4 inch, but less than one inch in width must be sealed prior to application. Use an approved sealant such as Sikaflex 1c SL single component, self-leveling premium grade polyurethane sealant with an accelerated curing capacity.
- 7 Asphalt sealcoat will not be placed until the ambient temperature is at least 55 degrees and rising prior to the application.
