SCC has revised sheet E1 to show (1) light fixture at top of page in clouded area to be feed from existing light pole to new fixture. Delete boring/cutting sidewalk as originally proposed for this (1) light fixture.

Questions we received and our Answers are in Red:

- 1.) Sheet E-2 Note 4 states that all wiring and raceways be concealed and that will not be possible at the retaining wall.

Answer: **Note 7- Mentions what is concealed on wall will be painted to match wall. Architect to approve.**

- 2.) The fixtures selected have dimming capability but no requirement for dimming conductors are listed in the scope of work.

Answer: **Fixtures will not be dimmed. Full output on lighting voltage.**

- 3.) The in ground junction box at the left side of Sheet E-1 or the Southwest corner is in an area that landscaping mowers will be driving over them and would require a “quazite” style junction box with “electrical” stamped in the cover. The other areas are mulched and should only need PVC ground mounted junction boxes. I’ve attached a picture of the quazite box style.

Answer: **Engineer didn’t specify any particular type j-box. Install regular PVC j-box as all others will be. We can encapsulate that with other mulch in that location after project is completed.**
